## End of KS1 and KS2 Data 2020

Table shows the percentage of children who were Year 6 in 2020 achieving the expected standard or above. Due to Covid 19 lockdowns and decisions by the Government to postpone SATS testing for this cohort – these results are based upon internal data tracking and SATS practise assessments.

Year 2 cohort 2020 - this is a very small cohort of only 5 children at the point of SATS with a lot of mobility in and out of the year group

The phonics screening check was not carried out in Summer 2020, instead children were tested in year 2 in December 2020.
