In School This Week

In Little Stars this week, we have been learning all about Road Safety for National Road Safety week. We have talked about the different crossing we've used, practiced crossing the road safety and the steps needed.





In Maths this week, Mercury class have started exploring shape. They have been learning the names of 2D and 3D shapes, counting sides and vertices and discovering what shapes they can stack and roll. The children have enjoyed making pictures and patterns using 2D shapes and everyone has enjoyed drawing around shapes to create some interesting pictures and patterns. The children have been exploring the school

and grounds on a shape hunt and recording their findings using a tally chart. We have also started our Nativity practice this week which is very exciting.

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In Saturn this week, we have been thoroughly enjoying our reading, we are enjoying both our DERIC text 'Blossom' by Laura Dockrill and 'The Boy Who Grew Dragons' by Andy Shepherd. As well as this we have been enthusiastic about our reading for pleasure time in class and have loved making ourselves comfy while tucking into our books. In Science we have learnt about the digestive system and in English we are now planning our final piece of narrative writing.





In science in Neptune Class, we have moved onto electricity! We spent our first lesson exploring the basic components of a circuit and seeing if we could make them work. We will spend the next few lessons exploring how and why circuits work and how to make them more complex.'
