





Willow Class Spring Term Home Learning

	<p>Sculpture: Michelle Reader</p> 	<p>We will be exploring art created by Michelle Reader, who uses recycled materials to create sculptures of a variety of wildlife.</p> <p>We would love you to have a go at creating your own animal sculptures at home. You can copy the style of Michelle Reader and use recycled materials, go litter picking to collect items for your artwork, or you may wish to use clay or playdoh to make your creation.</p>
<p><b>Project 2 - Science</b></p> <p><b>How do plants grow?</b> Use our Plant Knowledge Organiser to discover more about plants and produce a piece of homework related to our study. Here are some examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grow a plant and observe it grow.</li> <li>• Draw, name and label a plant diagram.</li> <li>• Draw a picture of your favourite plant.</li> <li>• Take a photo whilst you do some gardening.</li> <li>• Identify different types of trees and their leaves.</li> <li>• Complete some artwork with leaves.</li> </ul>

 <p>Please continue to use Numbots to support your math's learning.</p>	<p><b>The UK and London</b></p> <p>We will be learning to name the countries that make up the UK, their capital cities and we will be exploring some of the landmarks of London.</p> <p>At home you could:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Create your own map of the UK.</li> <li>• Create a fact file about one of the countries (England, Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland) or a London landmark.</li> <li>• Create a picture of the 4 flags or the 4 flowers of each of the countries that make up The United Kingdom.</li> <li>• Explore and make some of the food that each county is famous for.</li> </ul>
